Thank you for the opportunity to provide an overview of the impact First Tee – Prairies is making, and outline a case for support to foster our expansion throughout Gladstone, MB and the surrounding area.

Golf Canada partnered with First Tee, an internationally renowned program with over 25 years of operation, in 2020 to launch First Tee – Canada. First Tee – Canada currently operates under six chapters.

First Tee – Prairies provides empowering opportunities through sport and fosters the continued development of life skills such as confidence, perseverance, and integrity through golf.

Our focus is to build community hubs made up of nearby golf facilities, schools, and community centres that create accessible pathways for golf participation. In 2023, the Gladstone Golf & Country Club was selected as the anchor course of the Community hub. Since then we have partnered with Gladstone Elementary, Austin Elementary, Plumas Elementary, Langruth Elementary, William Morton Collegiate Institute, Isaac Beliveau Memorial School and Gladstone Golf & Country Club.

Our programming is funded through generous corporate and individual donors. We depend on your support to help execute our program's mission to positively impact the lives of youth through golf.

Our supporters allow us to provide all school and community centre programming at no cost to participants and locations, including training, equipment, and lesson plans.
